

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF TOWAMENCIN COMMUNITY POOL

The following rules and regulations are for the purpose to ensure a clean and safe environment for the members and guests at the Community Pool.

Admittance:

Only pool members and paying guests will be admitted.

Must show proof of membership.

Children under the age of twelve will not be permitted to enter unless accompanied by an adult or responsible guardian **16** years of age or older.

Pool Areas:

All pools are under the direct supervision of lifeguards and management staff.

No running or any form of horseplay is allowed in the pool area.

No smoking is allowed inside the pool grounds.

No alcoholic beverages are permitted on pool grounds.

No gum chewing allowed in the pools.

No ball throwing allowed in pool unless approved by Pool Manager on duty.

No glass containers allowed.

Aqua shoes recommended for all pools.

Inflatables, including inflatable "swimmies" of any kind are not permitted during regular pool hours.

Coast Guard approved swim vests are permitted in the H or upper pool and baby pool

Diving Well:

Diving into the pool (except the diving well area) is not permitted. **Swimming in the diving area is not permitted.**

No hanging on diving board or buoy.

Only one person on a diving board at one time.

Please refer to posted signs behind diving board for your safety.

General:

No obscene or profane language allowed.

No vandalism allowed.

No loitering outside pool entrance

The Township is not responsible for articles lost or stolen.

No disposable diapers permitted in pool.

Closing:

The pool may close early (between the hours of 5:00 and 5:30) on the days the swim team has a home meet and for the yearly Swim Team picnic. Dates and times will be posted in advance.

The pool may be closed when there are less than ten (10) swimmers.

The opening and closing of the pool due to inclement weather is the sole decision of the Pool Manager on duty and will be consistent with Red Cross guidelines.

The pool closes at 5:00 PM on July 4th and 6:00 PM on Labor Day.

Pavilion Area:

Picnic tables are available for use by all pool members unless reserved for specific groups though Township permit. These events will be posted and Pool Staff will be aware of it.

Users must be responsible for cleaning area after use.

No grilling or open fire of any sort will be permitted at any time by individual users.

Unsafe behavior in the pavilion area will result in suspension of use as determined by Pool Manager and the staff.
