3. OLD BUSINESS

- Upcoming Events with Veterans Participation
 - Veterans Day November 11, 2024
 - Ceremony at Tennis Lukens Cemetery
 - A flag has been ordered. More information will be provided closer to Veterans Day.
 - Event for Veterans only at firehouse, Morgan Log House (MLH)
 - Bill Dauphinee is collaborating with Molly Johnson from MLH for an event aimed at facilitating networking among township veterans. The event is scheduled for September 14 in the afternoon at 4:30PM, to be confirmed. More details will be provided soon.
- Veterans Park Entrance Developments
- Carter's Review of Work needed at Tennis-Lukens Cemetery
 - Public Works has finished a lot of the work. For details on the completed and remaining work, refer to Dan Littley's presentation to the <u>Board of Supervisors at the July 10, 2024 Work Session</u> video at the 29:20 mark.
 - Installation of bench(es) at the cemetery as a Scout project was discussed. Next steps to be determined at the next Veterans Committee meeting.
 - Regarding headstone restoration: Molly Johnson at MLH has knowledge of headstone restoration. Molly will be invited to a future Veterans Committee meeting. Historical designation of

Tennis-Lukens (T-L) would help obtaining grant money for headstone restoration. There are eight headstones with flags. Work on designating T-L as a historical site began years ago. Dan Littley will work with Colleen to determine what steps were completed.

- Motion: Petition BOS to review remaining work at T-L. Seconded and approved.
- Listing/Register of Towamencin Veterans
 - Carter's suggestion of capturing the history of township veterans.
 - The Morgan Log House working to capture township Veterans' history using the <u>Library of Congress Veterans History</u> <u>Project (LoC/VHP)</u>
- Restoration of AME Cemetery, rehabilitation of veterans' headstones.
- Restoration of Tennis-Lukens Cemetery headstones.
- Veterans Memorial Park grants for the next phase of development.
- 250th Anniversary (October 2027) of the Continental Army at "Headquarters Towamencin" October 8-16, 1777.

 - Parade and Event at Hatfield Legion Post
 - "Taps" sounding at Tennis Lukens Cemetery
