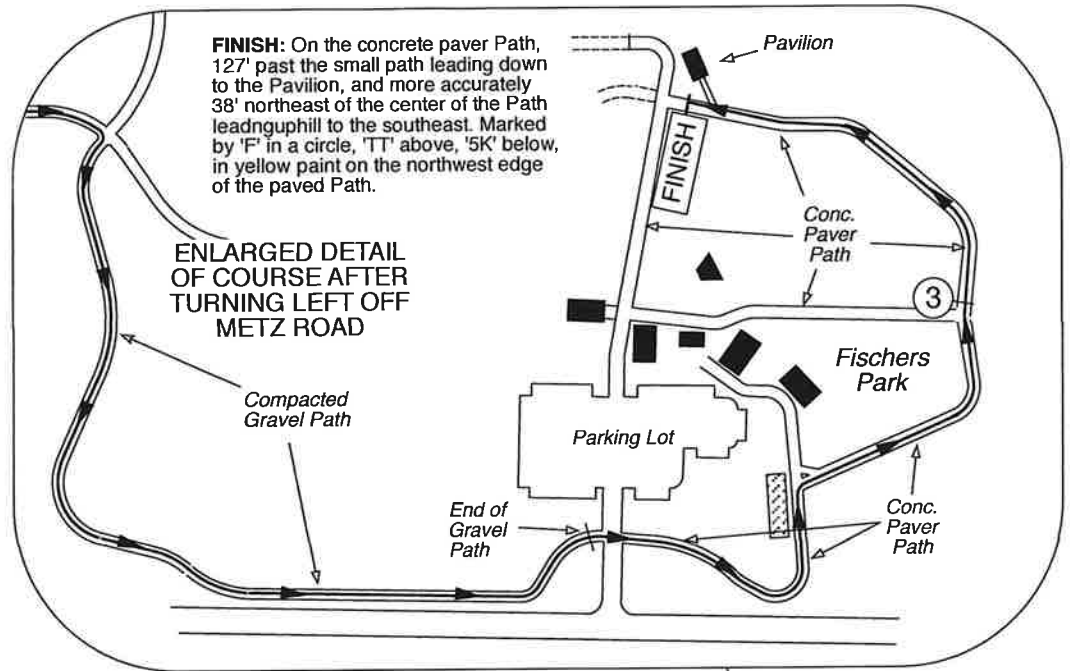

**FINISH:** On the concrete paver Path, 127' past the small path leading down to the Pavilion, and more accurately 38' northeast of the center of the Path leading uphill to the southeast. Marked by 'F' in a circle, 'TT' above, '5K' below, in yellow paint on the northwest edge of the paved Path.

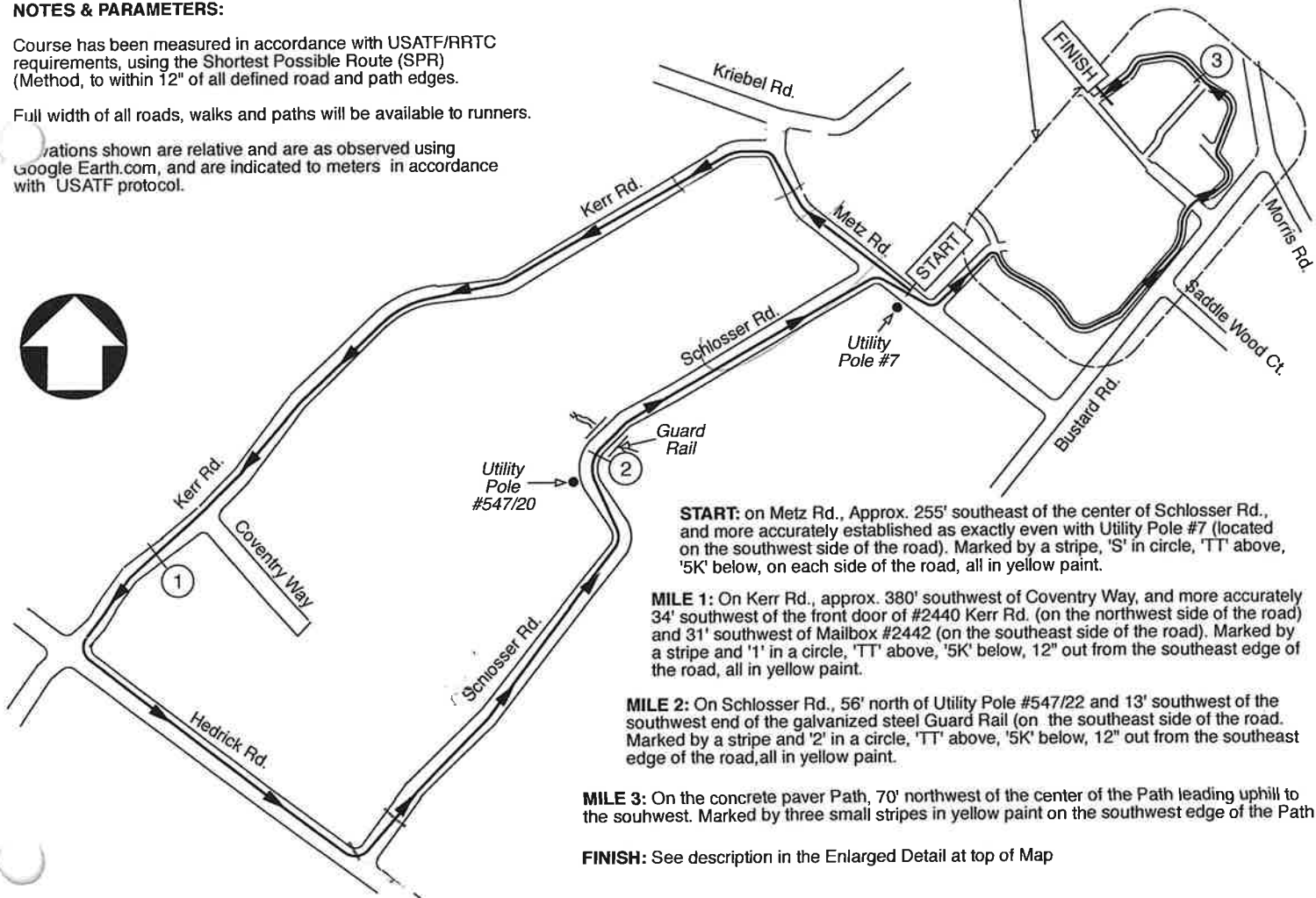
**ENLARGED DETAIL

**NOTES & PARAMETERS:**

Course has been measured in accordance with USATF/RRTC requirements, using the Shortest Possible Route (SPR) (Method, to within 12" of all defined road and path edges.

Full width of all roads, walks and paths will be available to runners.

Elevations shown are relative and are as observed using Google Earth.com, and are indicated to meters in accordance with USATF protocol.



**START:** on Metz Rd., Approx. 255' southeast of the center of Schlosser Rd., and more accurately established as exactly even with Utility Pole #7 (located on the southwest side of the road). Marked by a stripe, 'S' in circle, 'TT' above, '5K' below, on each side of the road, all in yellow paint.

**MILE 1:** On Kerr Rd., approx. 380' southwest of Coventry Way, and more accurately 34' southwest of the front door of #2440 Kerr Rd. (on the northwest side of the road) and 31' southwest of Mailbox #2442 (on the southeast side of the road). Marked by a stripe and '1' in a circle, 'TT' above, '5K' below, 12" out from the southeast edge of the road, all in yellow paint.

**MILE 2:** On Schlosser Rd., 56' north of Utility Pole #547/22 and 13' southwest of the southwest end of the galvanized steel Guard Rail (on the southeast side of the road). Marked by a stripe and '2' in a circle, 'TT' above, '5K' below, 12" out from the southeast edge of the road, all in yellow paint.

**MILE 3:** On the concrete paver Path, 70' northwest of the center of the Path leading uphill to the southwest. Marked by three small stripes in yellow paint on the southwest edge of the Path
