

RESOLUTION 26-17

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE 2026 ROUND OF GREENWAYS, TRAILS AND RECREATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Act 13 of 2012 establishes the Marcellus Legacy Fund and allocates funds to the Commonwealth Financing Authority for planning, acquisition, development, rehabilitation and repair of greenways, recreational trails, open space, parks and beautification projects; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Financing Authority and the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development are accepting applications for projects within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, applications and projects must meet all eligibility requirements within the Greenways, Trails and Recreation Program Guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Towamencin Township, in the County of Montgomery, PA, hereby requests a Greenways, Trails and Recreation Program (GTRP) grant in the amount of \$250,000.00 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for the construction of the driveway access, a 21-space parking lot (including two ADA parking spaces), the installation of an eight-foot wide ADA accessible trail, creation of a central lawn area and meadow in the farm field area, and associated stormwater management. The estimated project cost is \$1,812,157.00. The Township commits to providing the remaining funds for the project, estimated to be \$1,562,157.00 or 86% of the estimated project cost.

Be it FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Applicant does hereby designate David Kraynik, Township Manager and Eric Reinbott, Finance Director, as the officials to execute all documents and agreements between Towamencin Township and the Commonwealth Financing Authority to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.
